The assignment was “springtime and/or birds”. We had a lot of great photo submissions by 7 members this time. Thank you all for sharing.

Steve Fowler presented the topic of Art in Photography. He referred to it as the “abstract aspects of photography”. He talked about Art Wolf and his training program on Creative Live called “Create Art Through Photography”. We then viewed his 20-minute chapter on “Elements of Design in Photography”. Here’s a summary of what I managed to write down about it:

- Look for patterns, lines, and/or textures
- Start in close and then move out
- Make every corner of the image work for a photo to contribute to the greater whole
- Balance and movement of the eye is what you want in your image
- Assemblage – added elements to emphasize what the photographer wants you to see

Next, Jean Davids discussed starting up the Agenda Committee again as it has been more of a burden directly on her to push the agenda forward since we stopped having a committee. This time she hopes to make it truly a committee effort for coming up with ideas and scheduling them rather than it falling all on the chairperson’s shoulders. Everyone agreed to start it up again. Jean Davids volunteered to lead the group. We had 4 others volunteer to be on the committee. They are Anthony Hall, Craig Starr, Cindy Mendel and Kevin Juliot. She’s inviting all the local creative organizations to give them a chance to recruit and inform people about what they do. She wants to find out what we would like to do.

Cindy Mendel discussed briefly the banner contest that Monticello is having. Jean said she would send a note out to everyone about that. (Note: Cindy forwarded it to Jean afterwards and it was sent to all paid members.)
