The assignment was to share Sky Photos (solar eclipse or other). We had a few photos of the eclipse that were shared and a discussion of the experience was done. Both said the most difficult part was trying to point straight up in the sky to capture them as zoom lenses had gravity fighting keeping the length open and using a tripod required the constant readjustment as things changed position in the sky. Don shared some photos of the eclipse as well but was unable to attend. Several other really cool sky photos were also shared by others.

Heather Reinhart presented the topic "How to Develop Your Photography Style." She did a PowerPoint presentation on the topic and then shared some videos on the subject.
